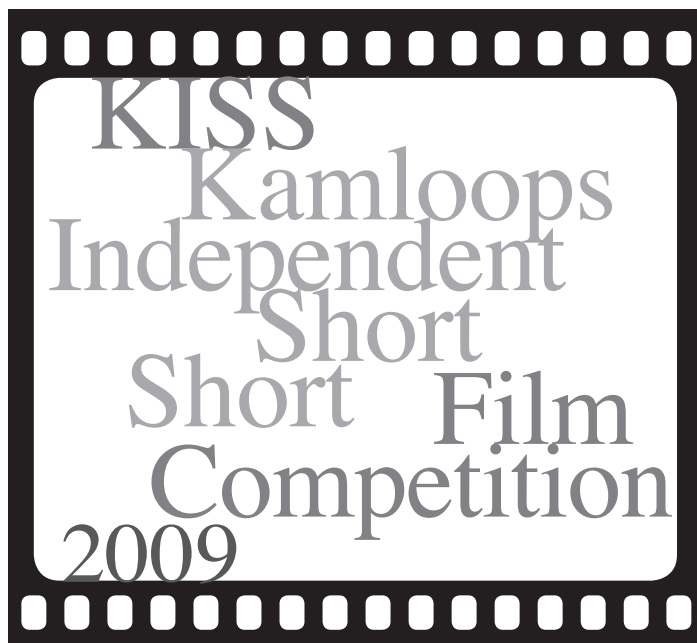

This competition is open to all residents of the Thompson Nicola Regional District excluding the Kamloops Film Society Board of Directors and their immediate families. Professional videographers are not eligible.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

All submissions:

- Must be a maximum of 5 minutes long.
- Must be made by residents of the Thompson Nicola Regional District.
- Must be suitable for viewing by all ages.
- Must be submitted on DVD.
- Must include a copy of the original file, (i.e., QuickTime or AVI) on a separate DVD or CD for a compilation we will make.
- Must be labelled with the film title, running length, contact name, and email address.
- May include a short (up to 150 words) biography of the filmmaker and a synopsis of the film (up to 200 words).
- May include production stills.
- Must not be your original material. KISS cannot return any submission materials.
- Youth award applicants must be no older than 17 as of May 1, 2009
- Must be dropped off at Moviemart, by 5:00 pm May 1, 2009 with a \$10 entry fee.

The Film Society reserves the right to reject or refuse any film that does not meet the submission criteria.

Please note that the Kamloops Film Society reserves the right to use clips and images from accepted films for promotional purposes, including possible exposure in print, radio, television, internet, and other media.
